5. Bialystok

Summer University Poland 2016

Bialystok, with a population of almost 400 000, is a city located in north-eastern Poland. Our city is serving the function of the capital of Podlaskie province. It is the administrative, economic, and academic centre of the region which, due to its exceptional environmental assets, has been termed the Green Lungs of Poland.





The history of the city dates back to 1320. In 1691 Bialystok received city rights from a Polish king Jan Sobieski III. The town was shaped by Jan Klemens Branicki, who developed it and built a splendid residence here. Bialystok is a provincial capital and the largest city in the north-eastern region of Poland. Bialystok is an important communication centre and owing to its close to border location, a gate to the East. At the end of the 19th century the city was inhabited by Poles, Russians, Byelorussians, Jews and Germans. This inspired doctor Ludwik Zamenhof, who was born in Bialystok, to create an international artificial language Esperanto.


